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GRANT APPLICATION

The W. A. Tucker Foundation makes grants as a normal part of their activities. Any non-profit or charitable organization that would like to begin the grant process must first fill out the application for initial consideration. The grant process consists of two parts; the application and an interview. The interview may be conducted in person at the organization's site, by phone, or by email. The normal process will involve a visit to the organization by one or more Foundation officers, Board members, or Grant Committee members.

When considering applying for a grant keep in mind the general philosophy of the Foundation, which is to improvement of the quality of human life by helping all people realize their fullest potential. This includes grants to organizations that provide recreational, social, health, or educational opportunities to people who may be of any age, infants to seniors.

Grants are for a specific purpose and applicants must demonstrate a need, identify what is to be accomplished, and be able to show measurable results at the end of the project. Examples include grants for painting forest fire lookouts, funding clean up of mountain trails, and the purchase of computer hardware and software for education purposes for qualifying organizations.

Instructions:

1. Please fill out all the information below. This information will provide the basis used in the consideration of the grant. The application may be filled out by an employee of the requesting organization but must be signed by an officer of the organization.
2. The organization making a request for a grant must be a non-profit company with a 501c3 or equivalent tax status.
3. The maximum grant will not exceed \$2000.
4. The purpose must be clearly defined, specific and measurable (e.g. to be used against matching funds for purchasing equipment for a nature center). All grants will be restricted.
5. Preference will be given for grants that have matching portions of cash. Work or services in kind will also be considered for matching grants.
6. Preference will be given to established and well-known non-profit and charitable organizations.
7. The decision will be based upon available Foundation funds for the year.
8. If partial funding is possible, the Foundation will discuss that option with the applicant.
